

What you must bring on your first day at college

Please check this list BEFORE you leave your home country. You will need all of these documents including the photocopies in order to register for your course:

- CAS statement. Please make one photocopy of this document.
- Your passport, and one photocopy of the outside cover of your passport, the picture page and your student visa.
- Your original academic qualifications. These must be translated into English by a qualified translator. Please make one photocopy of all of these documents.
- Your original English language score. Please make one photocopy of this document.
- Receipt of your deposit payment, plus payment for any other outstanding fees (cheque/credit card/debit card)
- Proof of your address in the UK (this could be your *Tenancy Agreement* from your accommodation, a Police Registration Certificate or utility bill)
- Two passport-sized photographs.
- Proof of Insurance Policy (or funds to pay for this on arrival)

You only need to bring these documents if they apply to you:

- If you are under 18 years old, you must bring a copy of your guardianship letter. Please make one photocopy of this document.
- If you are a sponsored student, you must bring your original Sponsorship letter. Please make one photocopy of this document.
