

Forster Street

The Forster Street accommodation is a modern development, offering comfortable and secure living in the Cotton Mills student community, within easy reach of the city centre and NTIC.

The accommodation consists of self-catering flats of four to six lockable bedrooms. Bedrooms are an ideal study environment with modern and comfortable furnishings. Students in each flat share bathroom facilities, and a large, well-equipped kitchen and lounge area where residents can eat and socialise together.

The flats are next door to the popular Cotton Mills residence, and all Forster Street residents have the benefit of accessing the facilities in Cotton Mills free of charge. Cotton Mills has a communal area, which includes a pool table and a gym, safe bicycle storage, laundry facilities and 24-hour security staff.

The accommodation is conveniently located opposite a large supermarket and a handy homeware store, and fewer than five minutes from local transport links. Nottingham's largest ethnic community is nearby in Hyson Green, offering a range of international cuisine and shopping. The local area boasts a large number of takeaways, cafés and pubs.

Accommodation details

Type of accommodation

Forster Street consists of self-catering flats of between four and six private, lockable bedrooms, with a shared bathroom, kitchen and lounge.

Location

NTIC and Nottingham city centre are a 20-25 minute walk away, or a single short bus journey lasting up to 10 minutes. The cost for a single bus journey is £1.60. The nearest supermarket is just around the corner.

Kitchen

Each flat is self-catering and comes with a fully equipped kitchen, containing a fridge, freezer, cooker and microwave.

Living room

There is a lounge area connected to the kitchen with a dining area and comfortable sofas.

Rooms

Each bedroom has a large, three-quarter sized bed, desk, wardrobe and storage.

Internet

Broadband internet is available in all flats.

Utilities

Electricity, gas and water are included in the accommodation fee. Electrical current is 240 volts AV (50 cycles) and students from some countries may require a transformer and plug adaptor.

Communal facilities

Cotton Mills has a communal area, which includes a pool table and a gym, safe bicycle storage and laundry facilities. All Forster Street residents have access to these facilities free of charge.

Laundry and cleaning

There are laundry facilities in each flat, and you may also use the laundrette facilities in the Cotton Mills complex. Communal areas will be cleaned, but all students are responsible for keeping their flats clean and tidy.

Security

Forster Street has a controlled entry system and a modern fire prevention system. Security staff are located at the next door Cotton Mills, and can be contacted 24-hours a day.

Disabled access

Forster Street has disabled access and some suitable rooms. Please inform NTIC as soon as possible if you have a disability, to ensure any special arrangements can be made in advance.

Visitors and noise

Residents are allowed guests overnight for up to two nights each week. Students are expected to keep noise to a minimum after 10pm and be considerate towards their neighbours.

Availability

Forster Street is offered to all students aged 17 and over, subject to availability. Students aged 16 may be admitted at the discretion of the Manager and college.
