

Riverside Point

Riverside Point offers premium student accommodation at an affordable cost within easy reach of Nottingham city centre and Nottingham Trent International College.

The accommodation consists of self-catering flats of up to six private, lockable bedrooms. Bedrooms benefit from a larger bed (3/4 sized) and a comfortable desk, making the ideal quiet study environment. Each flat has a well-equipped kitchen connecting to an inviting lounge area with a television, where flatmates can cook and socialise. Riverside Point has a communal area where students can play pool, and offers use of the gym facilities at the nearby St Peters Court residence.

Riverside Point is located in the Lenton area, a popular choice for students in the city. A free bus shuttle service operates between Riverside Point and the city centre and NTU city campus. Riverside Point prioritises security, and with CCTV, secure door entry and 24-hour security you can always have peace of mind.

Accommodation details

Location

NTIC and Nottingham city centre are a 25-30 minute walk away. You can use the free shuttle bus between Riverside Point and NTU city campus, where NTIC is based, which takes less than 15 minutes. A taxi from the city centre to Riverside Point costs between £6-£10. There is a small convenience store close by, and the nearest supermarket is less than 20 minutes walk away.

Kitchen

Each flat is self-catering and comes with a fully equipped kitchen, containing a fridge, freezer, cooker and microwave.

Lounge Area

There is a lounge area in each apartment. This is connected to the kitchen and contains a sofa and widescreen TV, and dining area.

Rooms

Each bedroom has a large bed (3/4 sized), a desk, shelves, a wardrobe and storage, as well as a quality en suite bathroom.

Utilities

Electricity, gas and water are included in the accommodation fee. Electrical current is 240 volts AV (50 cycles) and students from some countries may require a transformer and plug adaptor.

Communal facilities

There is a common room for use by all residents free of charge, which includes a pool table. Residents of Riverside Point also may use the gym facilities located at the nearby St Peters Court residence free of charge.

Internet

Broadband internet is available in each bedroom.

Laundry and cleaning

There are laundry facilities on site, use of which incurs a small charge. Communal areas will be cleaned, but all students are responsible for keeping their flats clean and tidy.

Security

CCTV is in operation on the premises and security staff are available 24/7. Each flat has a controlled entry system. Bedroom doors should be locked whenever you leave the room.

Disabled access

Riverside Point has disabled access and some adapted rooms. Please inform NTIC as soon as possible if you do have a disability, to ensure any special arrangements can be made in advance.

Visitors and noise

Residents are allowed guests overnight for up to two nights each week. Students are expected to keep noise to a minimum after 10pm and be considerate towards their neighbours.

Availability

Riverside Point is offered to all students aged 18 and over, subject to availability. Students aged 17 may be admitted if they will turn 18 within their first term of study at NTIC.
